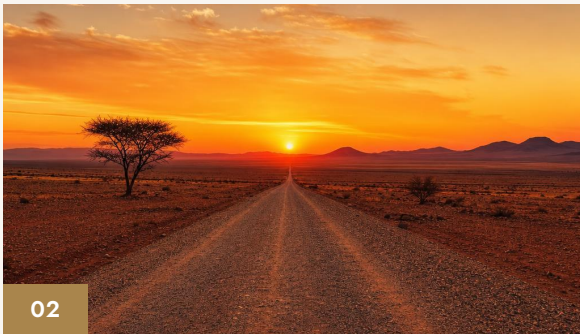

Scenic transfer to the coast along the legendary Skeleton Coast, where towering dunes plunge dramatically into the ocean.

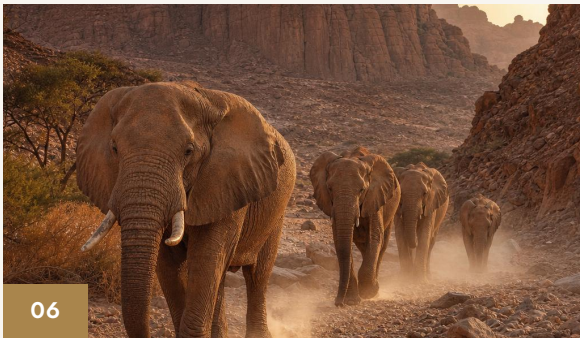

Morning kayaking with Cape fur seals at Pelican Point and afternoon sandboarding on the Atlantic coastal dunes.

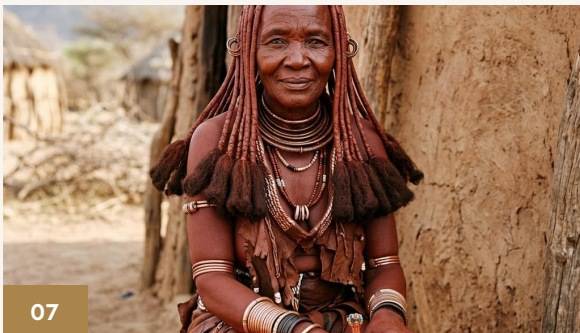

Arrival at Etosha National Park. First game drive at dusk across this vast salt pan of 4,731 km².

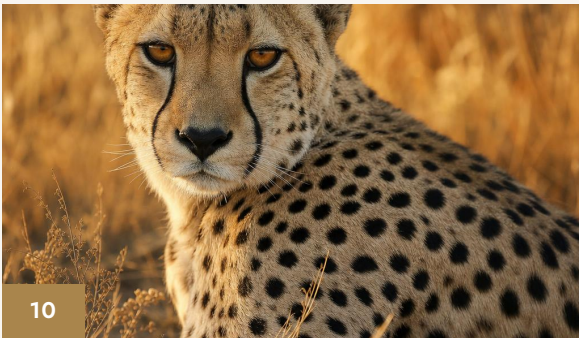

BEFORE YOU GO

Practical information

BEST SEASON

May to October is the ideal dry season: wildlife concentrated around waterholes and clear skies. July–September offers perfect temperatures.

CURRENCY & PAYMENTS

Namibia uses the Namibian Dollar (NAD), pegged 1:1 to the South African Rand. Luxury lodges accept cards. Carry cash for markets and tips.

DOCUMENTATION

Passport valid for at least 6 months after departure. EU, UK and US citizens do not require a visa. We recommend digital copies in the cloud.

HEALTH & VACCINATIONS

No mandatory vaccines required. Antimalarial medication is recommended for Etosha and the north. Consult your doctor 6–8 weeks before departure.

CLIMATE

Warm days (25–35 °C in dry season) and cool nights (8–15 °C). Pack layers. High-SPF sun protection is essential in the desert.

CONNECTIVITY

WiFi in lodge communal areas. Signal is limited in remote areas — a blessing for disconnecting. Local SIM cards available in Windhoek.
